MATHMOD 2009 Contributions – post- conference Publication in MCMDS

The publishers of the MATHMOD Proceedings, I. Troch and F. Breitenecker, hold the copyright for publication of MATHMOD 2009 papers. Any paper submitted is automatically considered for publication either in its original form or in a suitably enlarged version

- in **MCMDS**, the journal *Mathematical and Computer Simulation of Dynamical Systems*, EiC I. Troch, published by Taylor and Francis or,
- in **SNE - Simulation News Europe**, published by EUROSIM/ARGESIM or,
- in a special issue of a suitable other scientific journal (e.g. JIRS, IMACS-MCS, CIT),

If the (corresponding) author is not notified within five months after the date of MATHMOD 2009 (July 10, 2009 at latest), that the paper will be considered for publication in one of the journals mentioned above, the paper is released for publication elsewhere. In this case, the publication must contain reference to the paper having been presented at the MATHMOD 2009.

SNE - Simulation News Europe

The journal SNE - Simulation News Europe – is intended

- to inform about developments in modelling and simulation by technical notes, education notes, short notes, software notes and benchmarks - *Notes Section*, and
- to report about news from European simulation societies and events from International Simulation Societies and Simulation Groups all over the world - *News Section* (official membership journal of EUROSIM).



SNE's Notes Section publishes technical notes and education notes (fully peer reviewed), short notes (peer reviewed), and software notes on general overviews or new developments, on new software and hardware, on new applications and methods, and book reviews on recent books in modelling and simulation and in related areas.

ARGESIM Benchmarks. SNE's special series *Benchmarks of Modelling and Simulation Technique and Tools* (ARGESIM Comparisons) gives a comprehensive overview on developments in application and implementation. These ARGESIM benchmarks have become well-known benchmarks for modelling and simulation.

SNE Webpage. Begin of 2009, SNE comes up with a new webpage, which will not only document SNE and its contents, but which will also organise SNE administration in submission, reviewing, publishing, and distributing contributions, and it will allow to evaluate the ARGESIM benchmarks. Authors may submit contributions of any kind via this system, followed by an appropriate reviewing. Also reports from societies will be managed by this system, so that new SNE issues can be compiled in time on basis of reviewed and refined contributions. This new webpage is demonstrated at MATHMOD 2009 at the SNE – EUROSIM / ASIM booth.
